Before the trophies, the titles and the state-of-the-art distribution center, there was one small store, opened in 1960 in Columbus, Ohio, by Jeg Coughlin, Sr. Jeg loved to race and his dream was simple: find for himself, and sell to others, the hard to find auto parts that gear-heads and speed freaks wanted and needed. Before long, JEG'S Automotive, Inc. became THE place to go for people who were serious about their cars, and what went on it and inside it.



JEG'S growing success was just half of the story. Jeg Coughlin loved to race, and he was doing more than just showing up; he was winning. In 1970 he was named NHRA Sportsman of the Year and JEG'S was becoming a household name in racing circles. If you stopped right there, you'd have a hell of a story: one man, his passion and his dreams for a successful business. But for the Coughlin's, it's just the beginning. In 1988 Jeg's four sons, John, Troy, Mike and Jeg Jr., purchased the family business, with the assistance of their father, and dove head first in to the burgeoning mail-order catalog industry. Before long, business was booming and what began as a 4,000 square foot warehouse was being added onto almost annually. And as the family business grew their commitment to championship racing deepened. All four sons have raced in numerous classes throughout the sport of drag racing and have claimed over 100 victories as a family. Jeg Jr., in particular, has

made a name for himself as one of NHRA's most successful and high-profile drivers. The youngest of the four brothers as won three championships. His first was in '92 in Super Gas and has par laid that into two professional championships in Pro Stock, which is considered to be the most competitive professional class in the NHRA POWERade Drag Racing Series.
